

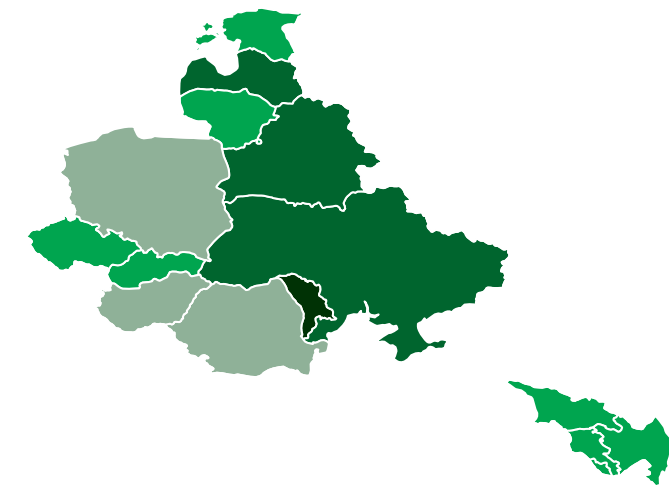

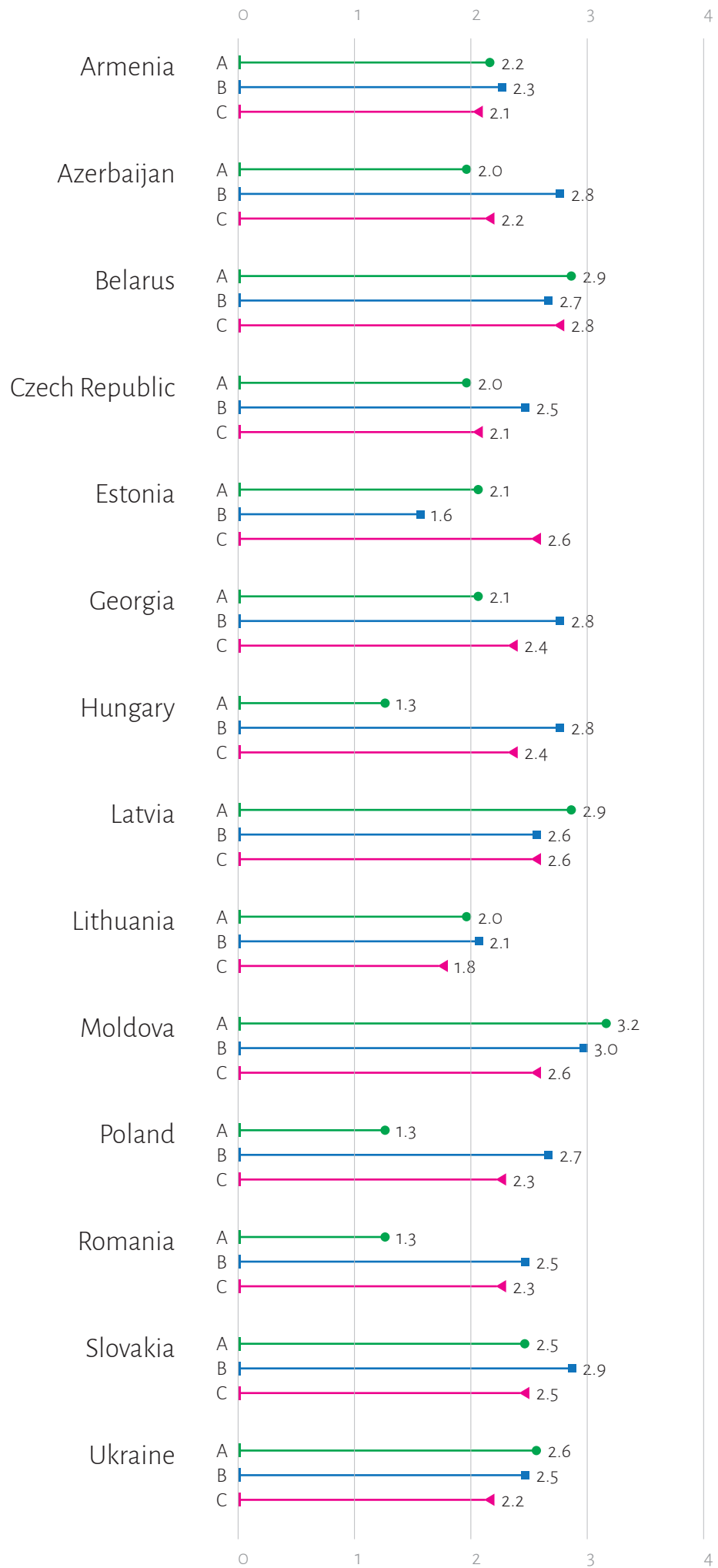

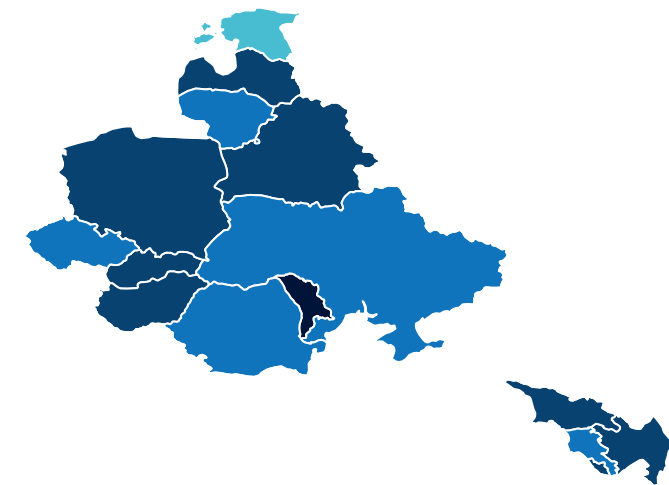

C Digital warfare vulnerability, the higher the larger a country's vulnerability to masked sources of disinformation.

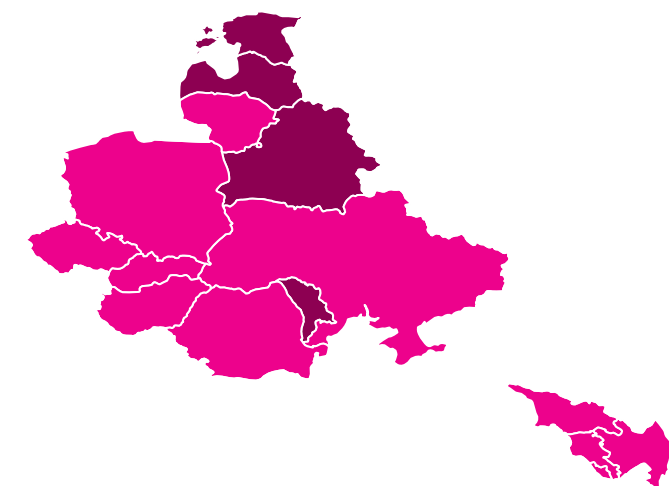
